There will be awesome displays in Carlisle's invitational building showing both kit car designs and some exotic imports from around the world. See all the major kit car manufacturers and their newest creations on display. Kick back and listen to live music on Saturday afternoon and evening. After a fun day on the grounds, sample the fine cuisine that the Carlisle area has to offer or go for a ride through the beautiful Cumberland County countryside.
